

UPDATE: TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Week of August 4-11, 2023

Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes around the project when possible to balance the traffic volumes during the peak morning and evening commutes. Delays should be expected.

Crews will be working to complete the sewer line and manholes in the RFTA BRT location early next week. Work next week will also consist of excavation, shoring, and building forms for the CO 82 underpass.

Anticipated traffic impacts are:

- Right lane closure of southbound CO 82 from 9:00 AM 2:00 PM today, Friday, August 4 to re-align the concrete barricades.
- 27th Street to a single lane with a flagger east of CO 82 on Saturday, 8/5/23 to set concrete barricades.
- Roaring Fork School District-RE 1 is back in session beginning August, 17 so future traffic impact updates will address lane closures around that time. Please also note there will be an increase in traffic congestion.








Pedestrians must use the identified alternate pedestrian routes and do not cross at the CO 82 & 27th Street intersection.

Phase 1 New Traffic Alignment

- 1. Temporary realignment is in place.
- 2. Construct east half of CO 82 underpass and related improvements on southeast corner through October 2023.

Pedestrian Impacts

- Pedestrians will not be allowed to cross the CO 82 Corridor at 27th St for the duration of the project.
- In addition, Pedestrians will not be allowed to cross 27th St. on the west side of the intersection.
- All pedestrian crossings of CO 82 will occur at 23rd St. A temporary pedestrian route on East 27th St will allow users to access the transit station and continue south along the CO 82 corridor.

Closure Area

Pedestrians will not be allowed to cross CO 82 or 27th St. at the intersection



Detour Route

Pedestrians will be rerouted around the construction at the RFTA 27th St station to continue along CO 82.

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Rio Grande Trail Impacts

- The Rio Grande Trail will be closed and detoured from late April 2023 until the project completion in October 2024.
- Directional and wayfinding signs will guide trail users from the detour that will go from 29th St. to Grand Ave. until it ties back into the Rio Grande Trail at 23rd St.

Closure Area

Pedestrians will not be allowed to access the Rio Grande Trail from this location.



Detour Route

Pedestrians will be rerouted to Glen Ave. from 23rd St. to 29th St. and then back onto the Rio Grande Trail.
